The Public Service Commission (PSC) is established under Section 105 of Belize Constitution (Third Amendment) Act No. 2 of 2001 and consist of a Chairman and five other members.

The Power of the Public Service Commission are listed below:

- Power to appoint persons to hold or act in office in the Public Service, other than the office in the judicial and legal services and the security services.
- Power to transfer or to confirm appointments.
- Power to exercise disciplinary control over persons.
- Power to remove such persons from office

These powers are itemized as follows:

1. Appointment
2. Transfer
3. Promotion
4. Removal from office
 - i. Dismissal
 - ii. Retirement
 - iii. Termination
5. Discipline

The Public Service Commission shall, in the exercise of its functions, be governed by the regulations made under section 106(3) of the Constitution.

The Public Service Commission, may by directions in writing and subject to such conditions as it thinks fit, delegate any of its power to anyone or more members of the Commission or, with the consent of the Prime Minister, to any Public Officer.
